If you take a name/town, I will <u>not</u> mark a prayer shawl sent unless you follow-up and tell me you have done so.

The list of towns below includes "Next-of-Kin" of Army casualties who we have <u>not</u> delivered prayer shawls through our direct <u>contact/mail program</u>. It **is** likely a few members of these families have visited Dover Air Base and chosen a prayer shawl before witnessing the Dignified Transfer Ceremony. Often they return home wishing they had taken more, wanting to comfort a grief-stricken sister, grandparent, special aunt, uncle, or for the soldier's children. If you would like to contact these families to offer a prayer shawl, send me a list of the towns. (Note: Repeat towns have been eliminated - multiple next-of-kin may be associated with a town.)

My husband is a wounded warrior and we're both members of our local DAV group, so what you do is near to our hearts. I'm honored to be invited to participate in your wonderful knitting ministry. I am part of a small group of men and women who knit and crochet in our church. We respond to the need - preemie hats and socks, chemo caps, warm hats and mittens for school kids, and of course prayer shawls. One family lost their 7-day-old infant, born prematurely. The family asked that preemie caps be made in his memory and sent to our neonatal intensive care unit. We sent 12 hats. I've attached some photos of my recent projects. I'm afraid my output might be meager; I'm up to my ears in

projects for church and the holidays. I'd love to get your newsletter and I have cast on one shawl for you! Blessings, Kathryn







III. DOVER PROGRAM:

Many of you will remember Chaplain Dave Sorensen, the man who made the call to request we send prayer shawls to Dover – we owe him a huge thank you for setting up the program and the relationship we have with Dover Air Base. I told him how well I remember that day when he called to request our help. It will always be very special to me, as I hope it is with each of you!

Dave was asked to write in "The New Prayer Shawl Companion" about our Dover program. It's a great story! I encourage you to buy this book for reasons beyond the patterns – it has some lovely poems, inspirational ideas, shared stories of interest! I was happy to hear from Dave, now back home in Wisconsin. He says:

That was a blessed time for me, too. I will never forget the looks on the faces of mothers, wives, sisters, fathers, brothers, and other relatives as they welcomed the prayer shawls, taking the one that spoke to them in a way that would serve to help them remember not only that there were people praying for them, but also would help them to remember their deceased loved one. I was blessed to be a link in your outreach to them. I will go to the website and buy a copy of the book. 
