I am pleased to pass on requests like this – what a wonderful conduit we have become! While these numbers will not become part of our prayer shawl count, they are just as important in the healing, peace, and comfort our work offers. Thank you for all you have done here! These past two months we have had 6 direct requests, including 3 gold star prayer shawls to gold star mothers. Sadly, we also have had requests for military who have returned home and committed suicide. Somehow, suicide strikes us as more ironically tragic and difficult to cope with. I thank all of you for continuing our good work, trying to heal with our busy hands. As usual, when I receive a direct request, I first contact those of you in the same state. If it's for a GS prayer shawl, I have a list of names to contact. If you wish to be added to that list, please let me know. Requests seem to come in clumps – a few one month, then none. ARMY'S CASUALTY LIST:

This list allows direct contact with our families. Contact me with the cities, and I'll send you the information. For easy Instructions how to Google a military name and leave a message on the family's "message board" or "guest list", visit our website. Please remember to keep me up-to-date of how many prayer shawls you send to these families so that we may keep accurate statistics. If you take a name/town, I will <u>not</u> mark a prayer shawl sent unless you follow-up and tell me you have done so.

Note: It is likely a few members of these families have visited Dover Air Base and chosen a prayer shawl before witnessing the Dignified Transfer Ceremony. Often they return home wishing they had taken more, wanting to comfort a grief-stricken sister, grandparent, special aunt, uncle, or for the loved one's children. If you would like to contact these families to offer a prayer shawl, send me a list of the towns. (Note: Repeat towns have been eliminated - multiple next-of-kin may be associated with a town.

On May 17th, Karen Mordus, President of Friends of the Fallen, wrote:

I just wanted to reach out to you to say a quick hello and to update you on status of Friends of the Fallen as well as a request. We are starting to unfortunately pick up now with our fallen coming home. We are getting a lot of family coming to Dover AFB, as well as a lot of Unit Members to pay their respects at the Dignified Transfer of their fallen. So far, we have been able to share the Prayer Shawls with approximately 250 family members since the beginning of this year. We're not running out, but we're getting close. The comments we are receiving are "AMAZING", "SIMPLY BEAUTIFUL", "THESE WERE MADE FOR US?" We proudly display these shawls on our wrought-iron rack by our Grieving Center.

Karen also asked permission to use our name in an article The Fisher House would like to write on their center's prayer shawls – the positive impact the shawls have had on our military families. I am hopeful we will be able to share that article with you.


