We Need Your Help

Earlier this year we had a situation occur that caused us to consider possible changes in the way we locate prayer shawl providers. During a nine-day period we received five prayer shawl requests from the same state – a state where we have only two needle crafters affiliated with Prayer Shawls for Fallen Soldiers. We were able to find providers for all five shawls (from within the state and nearby states), but this prompted us to look closely at our list of shawl providers. There are several states with five or fewer needle crafters, and nine states without a single contact.

Our original idea to match a prayer shawl provider in the same state as the family member requesting the shawl was an attempt to minimize postage costs when mailing the shawl. However, it is now apparent to us that we may need additional help providing prayer shawls in those states with few (or no) providers. We intend to actively solicit more providers in those states, however, in the interim, we would like to establish a list of individuals or groups that are willing to send a shawl anywhere in the US. So if you/your group would be willing to provide shawls anywhere in the country, please e-mail us at ps4fs2@gmail.com and let us know we may contact you/your group for any requests. If you/your group wants to continue providing shawls locally, that is completely understandable, and we will continue to contact you when we receive a request in your state, however, if you can extend your ministry, we (and, more importantly, the family members of fallen service personnel) will greatly appreciate it.
