# Program Update

It has now been 18 months since we received a Next-of-Kin list. Following consultations with other registered charities that also were no longer receiving the NOK lists, we were asked to request congressional intervention. We sent a letter by registered mail to the Chair of the House Armed Services Committee in August asking for help in determining when (or if) we would begin receiving them again, but no reply/response was provided.

Since the House was recessed for over two months in the fall, we thought perhaps the letter was lost. So earlier this month we delivered a copy of the letter in person to the Congressman's office. Still no response.

If you learn of a family near you who has lost a servicemember on active duty, please reach out to them and offer Prayer Shawls as you are able. If you are unable to provide Prayer Shawls or uncomfortable approaching the family, then please send us what information you have. We'll be glad to reach out.
